About the Artist


Dr. Peter Eveland has been a professional organist, pianist and composer since the age of eleven. As a child prodigy, he began entertaining on the Delta Queen Steamboat and worked his way up to being the Assistant Entertainment Director with responsibility for nightly shows, hiring and booking musicians, producing and directing shows nightly, along with sing-a-longs and play-offs all while leaving ports daily.



In addition to serving as National Staff Artist for the Wurlitzer Company, he also held the position of Staff Organist with the Cincinnati Bengals football team and the Cincinnati Stingers Hockey Team.

Pete was inducted as the youngest member and only organist into the Louisiana Jazz Club Hall of Fame. His composition, *An Afternoon with Daisy*, was released nationally on the famed Seven B jazz label featuring Pete with the Royal Canal Street Band. In addition to being a jazz, classical and theatre organist, Pete is also a ragtime aficionado.

Directly from the from the Pacific Northwest to the Sacramento area, let's give a big welcome to Peter Eveland.



- 1. Take I-80 to Davis and exit at Richards Blvd (exit 72B if coming from Sacramento)
- 2. Immediately merge left into the traffic lane that goes into the tunnel.
- 3. Turn left on 1st street.
- 4. Turn right on B Street and continue for four blocks.
- 5. Turn left on Russell Blvd and continue for three blocks.
- 6. Turn right on College Park Ave.
- 7. Wendell's home (#48) is in the far Northwest Corner of this Oval Street.
- 8. Park either in Wendell's driveway, or anywhere on College Park.
- 9. There are no parking restrictions on Sundays. Phone (530) 753-3916

Wendell has built a large music room on his property to house his collection of musical instruments, including a Calliope, a Merry-go-round band organ, a Honky-tonk piano, and numerous electronic organs. Of course, the centerpiece of the room is the restored 3/14 Moller Pipe Organ from the Lobby of the former San Francisco Fox Theatre.


