He's been working full-time for the last 2 1/2 years researching a forthcoming biography of legendary theatre organist George Wright. The book is scheduled for release in July, 2016. Bill loves playing ragtime and marches on the theatre organ, and has recorded a CD on an Allen GW-4 once owned by Walt Strony.


While not a player or technician, he remains fascinated by the mechanics and sound of these fabulous






